Internship Description

Reports directly to the Director of Events & Sponsorship; assists Event Marketing Coordinator in planning logistics for Chamber events and programs; assists in other Chamber work as needed; attends committee planning meetings as schedule allows.

Required Skills

A college junior or senior student pursuing a degree in Communication, Marketing, Advertising/Public Relations, Event Management or related field. Some previous internship or volunteer experience in specials events, public relations, or marketing is preferred. It is also required that the intern attend the special events and programs that he/she helps coordinate, unless there is a class conflict.

Other skills that would be beneficial to this position and are preferred: Excellent written and oral communication skills, strong organizational skills, accuracy and detail-oriented, works well under deadlines and prioritizes workload, full knowledge of Microsoft Office, and capacity to work independently, self-motivated, team player.
